## THE SOCIAL CONCERNS COMMISSION



The St. Peter's Cathedral recognizes our collective responsibility in caring for those in our community who are in need. This is consistent with the teachings of our faith and the Bible's call to "Bear one another's burdens and so fulfill the law of Christ." (Galatians 6:12). We look for opportunities to come alongside organizations that do this good work through financial support and direct volunteer services.

The Social Concerns Commission is one vehicle the Church uses to meet this responsibility. The Commission supports ten local organizations with a monthly financial gift. In addition, we volunteer at Helena Food Share, work with Family Promise with its service to homeless families, volunteer at Gods Love, Meals on Wheels, help with Tuesday showers, and other efforts to strengthen our community.

We are generously supported through the Christmas and Easter plate offerings, individual contributions by church members, Flipper Sunday proceeds, the Bargain Basement and other fundraising efforts. We also supported and benefited from the Heart of Helena event. The Commission appreciates the support shown of the Chapter and from individual church members.

**Family Promise** - Family Promise of Helena is dedicated to helping families find education, support, and to build a road to wellness and sustainable independence by utilizing the support of their community. We ask you to pray for FP families past, present and future as they face challenges that are unfathomable to many of us, and for the many FP volunteers who support this ministry.



Family 1 – Mom and 8 year old daughter. Mom passed another class with a B+ and will be starting her next course in her criminal justice studies this week! The daughter has some sensory processing issues and they find that traditional children's food are easiest for her to eat. Mom has been experiencing some health challenges with small seizures. A care plan has been written up to help others know what type of help she may need when she has the seizures.

Family 2 – Mom (47) and two daughters age 17 & 18. Mom is unable to have any lactose and dairy products. Older daughter has a banana allergy. Transportation is being provided by FP driver as they currently do not have a vehicle. The girls continue to work hard at school and spend a lot of time at the library. One of the girls is applying for part-time jobs. Mom is working as many hours as she can get and will begin a budgeting class with Family Promise staff this week.
