The Ramp Project continues!! **SAFETY FIRST:**



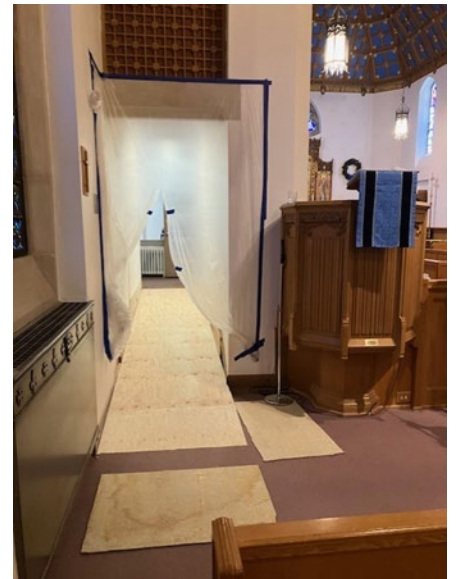
The construction crew is back to work after being gone for Thanksgiving holiday week.
