ALBAN, MARTYR, C. 304

Alban was a pagan citizen who sheltered a fleeing Christian priest. Moved by the priest's faith, Alban became a Christian and bravely swapped clothes with him to allow his escape. Arrested in his place, Alban refused to renounce Christ, becoming Britain's first martyr—a heroic witness to radical hospitality. He is the patron saint of Great Britain, converts, refugees, and torture victims.
