**Family Promise** - Family Promise of Helena is dedicated to assisting families who are facing homelessness by helping families find education, support, and to build a road to wellness and sustainable independence by utilizing the support of their community. Family 1 – Mom and 8 year old daughter. Mom continues her criminal justice studies and has found a new job! Car issues continue but mom is working to find a solution. The daughter has some sensory processing issues and is having a hard time with meals. Traditional children's food like mac and cheese, hot dogs, etc are easiest for her to eat.

Family 2 – Mom and two daughters age 17 & 18. Mom works until 6:30 p.m. so she does not have enough time to eat before going to the churches in the evenings. Her girls are helping by making her a plate so she can eat at the overnight location. Mom is unable to have any lactose and dairy products. Older daughter has a banana allergy. Transportation is being provided by FP driver as they currently do not have a vehicle.
