Family 2 – Mom and two daughters age 17 & 18. Mom works until 6:30 p.m. so she does not have enough time to eat before going to the churches in the evenings. Her girls are helping by making her a plate so she can eat at the overnight location. Mom is unable to have any lactose and dairy products. Older daughter has a banana allergy. Transportation is being provided by FP driver as they currently do not have a vehicle.
