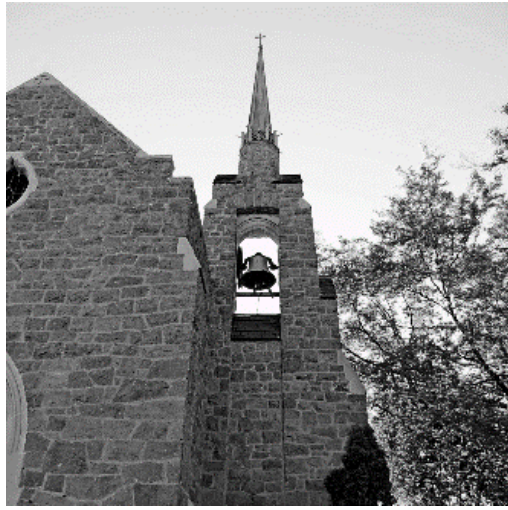


HAPPENINGS @ St. Peter's

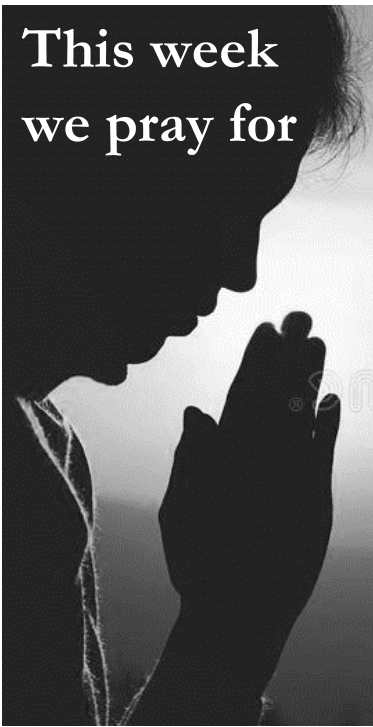

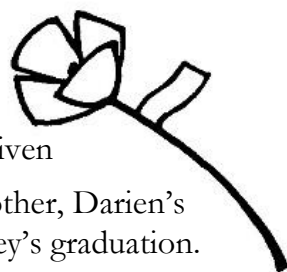
Mass On the Grass returns! St. Peter's will celebrate the 10:15 am Sunday Eucharist in Hill Park on the following dates.

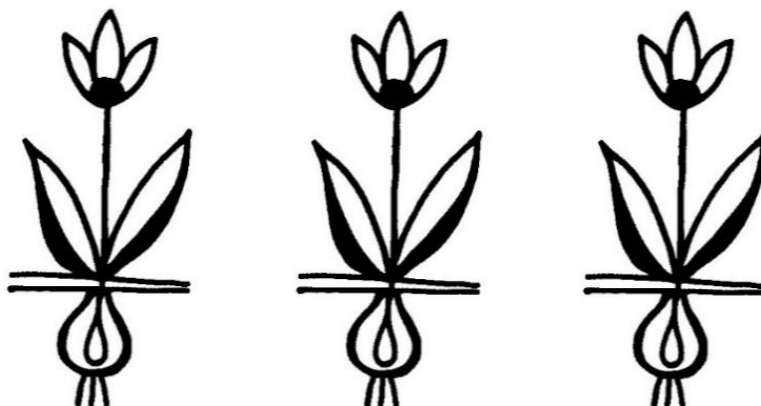

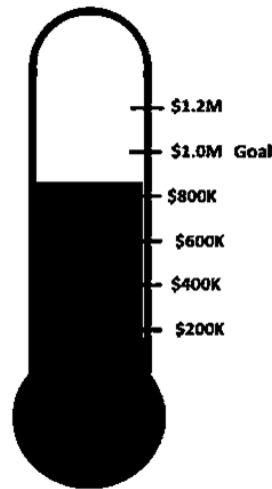
