

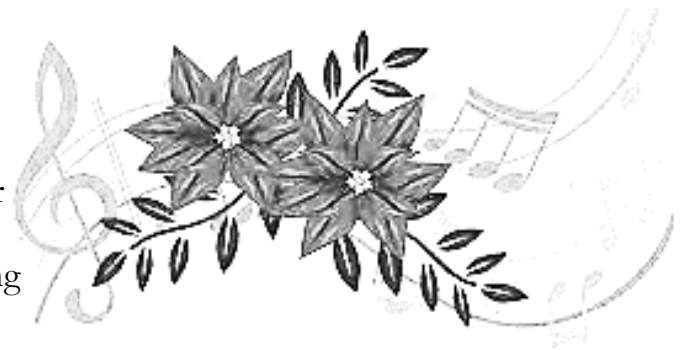
# HAPPENINGS AT ST. PETER'S

Wonderful Wednesdays and God & Grog will resume in January 2023.

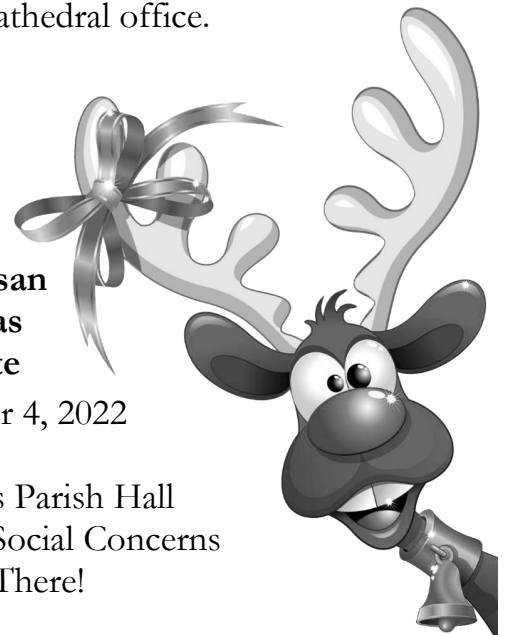
St. Peter's Cathedral's **Carol Sing-along** is scheduled for Saturday, December 24 before the 10:30 pm Christmas Eve Mass.

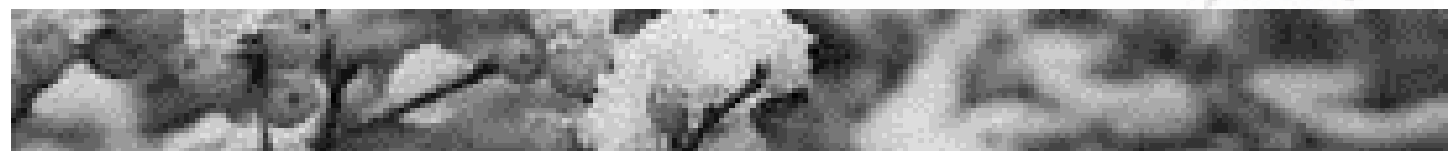

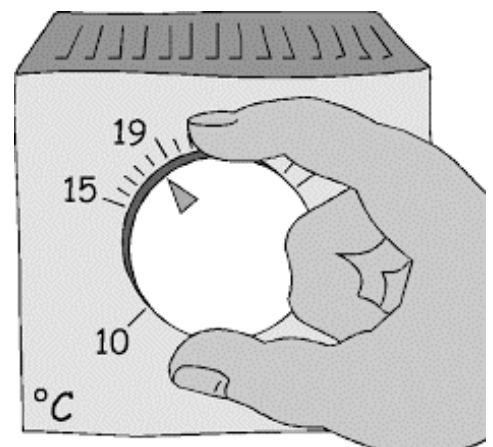
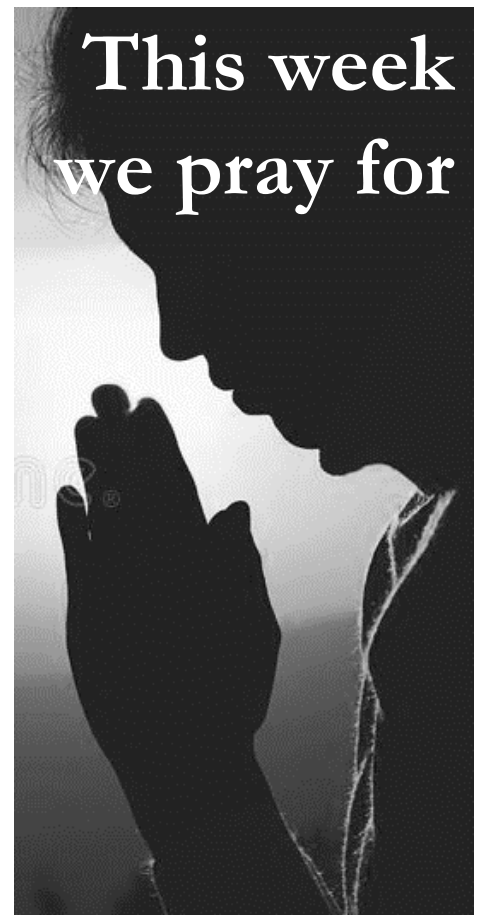
